ORDER

This matter having been opened to the Court by way of two Orders to Show Cause filed by both parties, each seeking temporary restraints, and briefs and affidavits having been submitted and oral argument having been heard, and for the reasons expressed on the record on this day, and for good Cause shown,

IT IS on the 8th day of March, 2007,

ORDERED that the interim consent order dated March 2, 2007 is vacated; and it is further

ORDERED that the corporate ownership shall be as it was prior to January 12, 2007; and it is further

ORDERED that the sole shareholder prior to January 12, 2007 was Kevin Medina, and he may undertake all activities that are in the best interest of the company immediately; and it is further

ORDERED that the transfer of the stock of Unifiednames to John Naruszewicz is declared null and void; and it is further

ORDERED that plaintiffs' attorney Paul Castronovo and the law firm of Mirzaian Schoenbrodt, LLP is disqualified from the representation of Unifiednames; and it is further

ORDERED that Kevin Medina is to retain an attorney to represent his interests within 10 days of the date of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1292(b), this Court is of the opinion that an immediate appeal from this Order may materially advance the ultimate termination of the litigation; and it is further

ORDERED that in light of same, this Court will grant permission of the parties to file an interlocutory appeal on this issue.
